Benjamin Gordon is an award-winning composer, producer and co-writer working across film, television, sync and pop. His music has been featured in Black Mirror, chosen by the National Ballet of Canada, and licensed to global brands including Apple, Google, Adidas, BBC and Netflix.

As a producer and co-writer he has worked with Nao, Sam Fischer, Elli Ingram and IAMROZE. His work spans four modes: cinematic scoring as Terra Symphonia, sync and commercial as All Good Folks, production and co-writing for artists, and personal records under his own name.
